



► Schouwen-Duiveland

On the Island of Schouwen-Duiveland different 'climate proof' solutions will be studied and demonstrated. A Climate Proof Strategy will be developed, based on a profound analysis of the effects of climate change. Within the area particular attention will be paid to the design of an area surrounded by dikes and water, for living, working and leisure.

Status June 2010

Aim 1: Analysing the effects of climate change for the island

The Climate Change Effect Atlas is ready and applicable for all projects in order to adapt the island to the changing climate. Effects on the social-economic level have been analysed as well. The project group and various stakeholders participated in a workshop to make the CPA project plans anticipate on this analysis.

- ▶ 12 April 2010: Workshop to render the Climate Proof Scenarios for Schouwen-Duiveland into a reference guide for the CPA projects (participants: project group)
- ▶ 13 April 2010: Workshop to discuss how 'climate proof' these projects are (participants: project group and De Kering, Havenplateau Bruinisse en Brouwershaven)

Aim 2: Developing long term vision plans realizing a safe and sustainable future (planet, people, profit).

During the CPA project, more innovative flood defences will be studied, including the regional water management in correlation to spatial planning.

- ▶ 9 March 2010: discussion maps with forum of development plan rural area
- ▶ March 2010: start-up Climate Proof Living by the students of the polytechnic school in Pontes
